THE PSYCHOSOMATIC APPROACH OF IRRITABLE BOWEL SYNDROME.

Abstract

Irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) is one of the most common functional gastrointestinal disorders. The pathogenesis is still investigated but motility, perception, signal transmission and processing in the ENC and CNS as well as the inflammatory trigger are involved in the occurrence of symptoms. Personality and psychosocial factors are strongly connected with IBS.

Given the chronic feature of the complains and the multifactoriality of this condition, the best approach is represented by the psychosomatic one. Based on the bio-psycho-social model of Engel developed by Drossman, a holistic management of indivual cases is the most successful atempt to fight IBS. Our lecture is a general review of updated knowledge on IBS and on EBM ways to approach this functional condition.
